As of June 30, 2018 the JIF has earned \$27,000,000 in surplus and returned \$22,000,000 of that to members in the form of dividends. Members were satisfied with the coverage and premiums of the JIF. Motion to renew membership to the NJUAJIF for (3) years and accompanying resolution was made by Mr. Cichone, seconded by Ms. Rohrbach, and carried with a roll call of ayes all, nays, none.
