### READINGTON-LEBANON SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

### November 21, 2017

- **OPENING:** Chairman, Dr. Schaible opened this regular meeting and announced that the Sunshine laws have been satisfied for the convening of this meeting.
- **PRESENT**: Dr. Schaible, Messrs. Burton, Cichone, Dr. Westfield and Ms. Rohrbach members, Mrs. Plesnarski administrator. Mr. Monaco did not attend.
- APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting of October 25, 2017 as written, was carried with roll call of ayes all, nays none.
- APPROVAL OF INVOICES: Motion to approve invoices for November in the amount of \$57,649.44 along with authorization for the Administrator to transfer this amount into the Operating Checking account on December 1, 2017 was made by Ms. Rohrbach. By same motion, approval and authorization of (1) invoice totaling \$1,035.00 to be paid from the General Fund Account on December 1, 2017, seconded by Dr. Westfield, and carried with a roll call of ayes all, nays none.
- APPROVAL OF BUDGET STATEMENT: Motion to acknowledge the review and approve the November Budget Statement without any exceptions noted as written was made by Mr. Cichone, seconded by Ms. Rohrbach and carried with a roll call of ayes all, nays none.
- NEW BUSINESS: Main Garage Building and UV Building Roof Replacement Mrs. Plesnarski informed the board that the garage of the main building was in need of replacement. The roof is the original roof and is past its expected life. Mr. Keating, maintenance supervisor had initially obtained quotes. Due to the need for a public works contractor's registration and prevailing wage initial quotes did not meet the local public

contracting law requirements. The cost for the project appeared to exceed our bid threshold. There is a need for the timely replacement of the roof so Mrs. Plesnarski felt that the use of the ESCNJ Cooperative was warranted. ESCNJ, Co-op# 65MCESCCPS has awarded a roofing and building envelope services contract# ESCNJ/AEPA IFB #017-F to Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc/Tremco Inc. Mr. Cichone questioned the credibility of WTI. Mrs. Plesnarski reminded him that ESCNJ had publicly bid the roofing contract and awarded the contract to WTI. Dr. Schaible is confident that the cooperative has done the due diligence required. Mrs. Rohrbach noted that even if we went to bid the project ourselves, we would also use the lowest bidder and not necessarily be familiar with the contractor. Dr. Westfield questioned when the project would begin. Mrs. Plesnarski noted that it would occur as soon as possible. The cost for the project is \$101,366.15. Mrs. Plesnarski noted that the price includes some asbestos removal and certified disposal. The project includes removal of existing roof, flashing, lightning rods and their replacement. Mr. Burton questioned the warranty. Mrs. Plesnarski stated that there is a 20 year warranty on material and labor. Mrs. Plesnarski informed the board that the UV Building was also in need of a new roof. Mrs. Plesnarski has evaluated the timely need to replace this roof and feels that the use of the ESCNJ Co-op contract# ESCNJ/AEPA IFB #017-F would be the most advantageous. The cost for this project is \$45,678.38. Motion to approve the roof replacement of the Garage Building Roof and UV Building Roof was made by Mr. Cichone, seconded by Dr. Westfield and carried with a roll call of ayes all, nays none.
